From Everlasting (Before the Beginning)

**Psalm 90:1-12    2 Peter 3:3-9    Genesis 1:1-5**

1. A man’s life is limited to about \_\_\_\_\_ or \_\_\_\_\_ years, but God exists forever!
2. “In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth...And there was evening, and there was morning—the first \_\_\_\_\_.” (Gen. 1:1-5 NIV)

To Everlasting (After the End)

**Zechariah 2:1-5 / 14:1-5    Revelation 11:1-3 / 16:17-19 / 19:11-16**

3. The very fact that God’s prophets record \_\_\_\_\_ events tells us that God exists outside of time.
4. Zechariah and John both wrote down what God \_\_\_\_\_ to them (in 520 BC and AD 81–96), and evidently they encountered each other in their visions.

# Psalm 90:1-12 (NIV)

## A prayer of Moses the man of God.

<sup>1</sup> Lord, you have been our dwelling place throughout all generations.

<sup>2</sup> Before the mountains were born or you brought forth the whole world, from everlasting to everlasting you are God.

<sup>3</sup> You turn people back to dust, saying, “Return to dust, you mortals.”

<sup>4</sup> A thousand years in your sight are like a day that has just gone by, or like a watch in the night.

<sup>5</sup> Yet you sweep people away in the sleep of death—they are like the new grass of the morning:

<sup>6</sup> In the morning it springs up new, but by evening it is dry and withered.

<sup>7</sup> We are consumed by your anger and terrified by your indignation.

<sup>8</sup> You have set our iniquities before you, our secret sins in the light of your presence.

<sup>9</sup> All our days pass away under your wrath; we finish our years with a moan.

<sup>10</sup> Our days may come to seventy years, or eighty, if our strength endures; yet the best of them are but trouble and sorrow, for they quickly pass, and we fly away.

<sup>11</sup> If only we knew the power of your anger! Your wrath is as great as the fear that is your due.

<sup>12</sup> Teach us to number our days, that we may gain a heart of wisdom.

## 2 Peter 3:3-9 (NIV)

<sup>3</sup> Above all, you must understand that in the last days scoffers will come, scoffing and following their own evil desires. <sup>4</sup> They will say, “Where is this ‘coming’ he promised? Ever since our ancestors died, everything goes on as it has since the beginning of creation.” <sup>5</sup> But they deliberately forget that long ago by God’s word the heavens came into being and the earth was formed out of water and by water. <sup>6</sup> By these waters also the world of that time was deluged and destroyed. <sup>7</sup> By the same word the present heavens and earth are reserved for fire, being kept for the day of judgment and destruction of the ungodly.

<sup>8</sup> But do not forget this one thing, dear friends: With the Lord a day is like a thousand years, and a thousand years are like a day. <sup>9</sup> The Lord is not slow in keeping his promise, as some understand slowness. Instead he is patient with you, not wanting anyone to perish, but everyone to come to repentance.

<p><b>Zechariah 2:1-5 (NIV)</b></p>	<p><b>Revelation 11:1-3 (NIV)</b></p>
<p><sup>1</sup> Then I looked up, and there before me was a man with a measuring line in his hand. <sup>2</sup> I asked, “Where are you going?”</p> <p>He answered me, “To measure Jerusalem, to find out how wide and how long it is.”</p> <p><sup>3</sup> While the angel who was speaking to me was leaving, another angel came to meet him <sup>4</sup> and said to him: “Run, tell that young man, ‘Jerusalem will be a city without walls because of the great number of people and animals in it. <sup>5</sup> And I myself will be a wall of fire around it,’ declares the LORD, ‘and I will be its glory within.’”</p>	<p><sup>1</sup> I was given a reed like a measuring rod and was told, “Go and measure the temple of God and the altar, with its worshipers.</p> <p><sup>2</sup> But exclude the outer court; do not measure it, because it has been given to the Gentiles. They will trample on the holy city for 42 months. <sup>3</sup> And I will appoint my two witnesses, and they will prophesy for 1,260 days, clothed in sackcloth.”</p>
<p><b>Zechariah 14:1-5 (NIV)</b></p>	<p><b>Revelation 16:17-19 and 19:11-16 (NIV)</b></p>
<p><sup>1</sup> A day of the LORD is coming, Jerusalem, when your possessions will be plundered and divided up within your very walls.</p> <p><sup>2</sup> I will gather all the nations to Jerusalem to fight against it; the city will be captured...</p> <p><sup>3</sup> Then the LORD will go out and fight against those nations, as he fights on a day of battle. <sup>4</sup> On that day <u>his feet will stand on the Mount of Olives, east of Jerusalem, and the Mount of Olives will be split in two from east to west, forming a great valley, with half of the mountain moving north and half moving south.</u> <sup>5</sup> You will flee by my mountain valley...<u>as you fled from the earthquake</u> in the days of Uzziah king of Judah. <u>Then the LORD my God will come, and all the holy ones with him.</u></p>	<p><sup>17</sup> The seventh angel poured out his bowl into the air, and out of the temple came a loud voice from the throne, saying, “It is done!” <sup>18</sup> Then there came flashes of lightning, rumblings, peals of thunder and <u>a severe earthquake</u>. No earthquake like it has ever occurred since mankind has been on earth, so tremendous was the quake. <sup>19</sup> <u>The great city split into three parts</u>, and the cities of the nations collapsed.</p> <p><sup>11</sup> I saw heaven standing open and there before me was a white horse, whose rider is called Faithful and True. With justice he judges and wages war. <sup>12</sup> His eyes are like blazing fire, and on his head are many crowns. He has a name written on him that no one knows but he himself. <sup>13</sup> He is dressed in a robe dipped in blood, and <u>his name is the Word of God.</u> <sup>14</sup> <u>The armies of heaven were following him</u>, riding on white horses and dressed in fine linen, white and clean. <sup>15</sup> Coming out of his mouth is a sharp sword with which to strike down the nations. “He will rule them with an iron scepter.” He treads the winepress of the fury of the wrath of God Almighty. <sup>16</sup> On his robe and on his thigh he has this name written:</p> <p>KING OF KINGS AND LORD OF LORDS.</p>
