Sermon Series: Q&A "Conflicts in Scripture"

"When I was seeking faith in God, and people told me to read the Bible, I did read it with earnest effort. I kept getting hung up on inconsistencies on the facts. It didn't bother me so much that The New Testament writers didn't tell the stories exactly the same way. What bothered me was that objective, indisputable facts were incongruous between different books of the Bible!

This helped to discredit all of Christianity to me. If this was God's word, and he promised to protect it through all of time, how could books with disagreeing facts make it into the Canon?!"

Q: Genesis 1:3-5 and 1:15-18 seem to contradict one another in the order that the sun was created.

Q: Also, Genesis 1:29 contradicts Genesis 2:16 directly, on a really, really important issue.

Another valid translation of Genesis 1:5:

"God called the light Day, and the darkness he called Night. This was the rise and fall of the first epoch."

Another valid way of interpreting these two passages (and the verses in between):

2. The first epoch began with the creation of the ______ (i.e., the "big bang") and continued until matter spread out sufficiently that light could escape the immense gravity (of what had been a singularity) and began to cast shadows.

3.	The second epoch continued until our system was partway through the process of formation. Within the accretion disk, the rocky planet that would come to be known as Earth began to form an atmosphere (the "firmament") with water vapor in the air and liquid water at the surface.
