Pastor and Sheila – they are both still working, both from home



Forty Days After Easter

1 Corinthians 15:3-620 Acts 1:3 Mark 16:1-8 Matthew 28:1-10,16 John 20:19,26; 21:1,14

- 1. After the resurrection, Jesus appeared to more than ______ people around Jerusalem and also 100 miles away.
- 2. The Gospels of Mark and Matthew tell the same story: the two ladies named Mary arrive at Jesus' tomb, and the angel that rolled the stone away tells them Jesus is

heading to ______. In Matthew, Jesus himself tells Mary that the disciples should meet him there. By the end of chapter, the disciples have met him there on a mountaintop.

3. In John's Gospel, Jesus visits the disciples twice in Jerusalem during the first week after the resurrection. Later, he sees them for the third time at the Sea of Galilee. His

message to them (spoken to Peter) is to "_____ my lambs."

The Great Commission

Matthew 28:18-20 Luke 24:45-51 Mark 16:14-20 Acts 1:3-5,8-9

- 4. After they left the Sea of Galilee and went to the mountaintop, this Jesus tells them to go to all nations and make disciples. This includes baptizing and _____.
- 5. In Luke's Gospel, Jesus told them that their work must begin in Jerusalem. That's close to the Mount of Olives (Bethany) where he ascended into Heaven. He told them

that they were witnesses of ______ and _____. So "witnessing" means telling people about these things.

6. Mark 16:16, "Whoever ______ and is baptized will be saved; whoever does not believe will be condemned." You are ultimately not responsible whether or not someone makes it to Heaven. You are only responsible to share the Gospel (to give people an opportunity to believe).

1 Corinthians 15:3-6 (NET Bible)

³...Christ died for our sins according to the scriptures, ⁴ and that he was buried, and that he was raised on the third day according to the scriptures, ⁵ and that he appeared to Cephas, then to the twelve. ⁶ Then he appeared to more than 500 of the brothers and sisters at one time...

Acts 1:3 (GNT)

³ For forty days after his death he appeared to them many times in ways that proved beyond doubt that he was alive. They saw him, and he talked with them about the Kingdom of God.

John 20:19,26; 21:1 (NIV)

¹⁹ On the evening of that first day of the week, when the disciples were together, with the doors locked for fear of the Jewish leaders, Jesus came and stood among them and said, "Peace be with you!"

²⁶ A week later his disciples were in the house again, and Thomas was with them. Though the doors were locked, Jesus came and stood among them and said, "Peace be with you!"

¹Afterward Jesus appeared again to his disciples, by the Sea of Galilee.

¹⁴ This was now the third time Jesus appeared to his disciples after he was raised from the dead. ¹⁵ When they had finished eating, Jesus said to Simon Peter, "Simon son of John, do you love me more than these?" "Yes, Lord," he said, "you know that I love you." Jesus said, "Feed my lambs."

Matthew 28:18-20 (NKJV)

¹⁸ And Jesus came and spoke to them, saying, "All authority has been given to Me in heaven and on earth. ¹⁹ Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, ²⁰ teaching them to observe all things that I have commanded you...

Luke 24:45-51 (GNT)

⁴⁵ Then he opened their minds to understand the Scriptures, ⁴⁶ and said to them, "This is what is written: the Messiah must suffer and must rise from death three days later, ⁴⁷ and in his name the message about repentance and the forgiveness of sins must be preached to all nations, beginning in Jerusalem. ⁴⁸ You are witnesses of these things. ⁴⁹ And I myself will send upon you what my Father has promised. But you must wait in the city until the power from above comes down upon you."

⁵⁰ Then he led them out of the city as far as Bethany, where he raised his hands and blessed them. ⁵¹ As he was blessing them, he departed from them and was taken up into heaven.

Mark 16:14-20 (GNT)

Jesus Appears to the Eleven

¹⁴Last of all, Jesus appeared to the eleven disciples as they were eating. He scolded them, because they did not have faith and because they were too stubborn to believe those who had seen him alive. ¹⁵ He said to them, "Go throughout the whole world and preach the gospel to all people. ¹⁶ Whoever believes and is baptized will be saved; whoever does not believe will be condemned. ¹⁷ Believers will be given the power to perform miracles: they will drive out demons in my name; they will speak in strange tongues; ¹⁸ if they pick up snakes or drink any poison, they will not be harmed; they will place their hands on sick people, and these will get well."


Jesus Is Taken Up to Heaven

¹⁹ After the Lord Jesus had talked with them, he was taken up to heaven and sat at the right side of God. ²⁰ The disciples went and preached everywhere, and the Lord worked with them and proved that their preaching was true by the miracles that were performed.]

Acts 1:3-5,8-9 (GNT)

³ For forty days after his death he appeared to them many times in ways that proved beyond doubt that he was alive. They saw him, and he talked with them about the Kingdom of God. ⁴ And when they came together, he gave them this order: "Do not leave Jerusalem, but wait for the gift I told you about, the gift my Father promised. ⁵ John baptized with water, but in a few days you will be baptized with the Holy Spirit."

⁸ But when the Holy Spirit comes upon you, you will be filled with power, and you will be witnesses for me in Jerusalem, in all of Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth." ⁹ After saying this, he was taken up to heaven as they watched him, and a cloud hid him from their sight.
