¹ ...Hezekiah became sick and was at the point of death. The prophet Isaiah...said to him, "Thus says the Lord: Set your house in order, for you shall die; you shall not recover."

² Then Hezekiah turned his face to the wall and prayed to the Lord: ³ "Remember now, O Lord, I implore you, how I have walked before you in faithfulness with a whole heart, and have done what is good in your sight." Hezekiah wept bitterly. ⁴ Before Isaiah had gone out of the middle court, the word of the Lord came to him: ⁵ "Turn back, and say to Hezekiah prince of my people, Thus says the Lord, the God of your ancestor David: I have heard your prayer, I have seen your tears; indeed, I will heal you; on the third day you shall go up to the house of the Lord. ⁶ I will add fifteen years to your life. I will deliver you and this city out of the hand of the king of Assyria; I will defend this city for my own sake and for my servant David's sake."
