

James 4:1-7 (CEV)

¹ Why do you fight and argue with each other? Isn't it because you are full of selfish desires that fight to control your body? ² You want something you don't have, and you will do anything to get it. You will even kill! But you still cannot get what you want, and you won't get it by fighting and arguing. You should pray for it. ³ Yet even when you do pray, your prayers are not answered, because you pray just for selfish reasons.

⁴You people aren't faithful to God! Don't you know that if you love the world, you are God's enemies? And if you decide to be a friend of the world, you make yourself an enemy of God.

⁵Do you doubt the Scriptures that say, ... ⁶... "God opposes everyone who is proud, but he is kind to everyone who is humble." ⁷Surrender to God! Resist the devil, and he will run from you.

Deuteronomy 4:37-38; 7:1-2,16; 9:4-5 (NCV)

³⁷ Because the Lord loved your ancestors, he chose you, their descendants, and he brought you out of Egypt himself by his great strength. ³⁸ He forced nations out of their land ahead of you, nations that were bigger and stronger than you were. The Lord did this so he could bring you into their land and give it to you as your own, and this land is yours today.

¹ The Lord your God will bring you into the land that you are entering and that you will have as your own. As you go in, he will force out...seven nations that are stronger than you. ² The Lord your God will hand these nations over to you, and when you defeat them, you must destroy them completely. Do not make a peace treaty with them or show them any mercy.

¹⁶ You must destroy all the people the Lord your God hands over to you. Do not feel sorry for them, and do not worship their gods, or they will trap you.

⁴After the Lord your God has forced those nations out ahead of you, don't say to yourself, "The Lord brought me here to take this land because I am so good." No! It is because <u>these nations are evil</u> that the Lord will force them out ahead of you. ⁵You are going in to take the land, not because you are good and honest, but because <u>these nations are evil</u>. That is why the Lord your God will force them out ahead of you, to keep his promise to your ancestors, to Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob.

Ecclesiastes 3:1-8 (KJV)

- ¹ To every thing there is a season, and a time to every purpose under the heaven:
- ² A time to be born, and a time to die; a time to plant, and a time to pluck up that which is planted;
- ³ A time to kill, and a time to heal; a time to break down, and a time to build up;
- ⁴A time to weep, and a time to laugh; a time to mourn, and a time to dance;
- ⁵ A time to cast away stones, and a time to gather stones together; a time to embrace, and a time to refrain from embracing;
- ⁶ A time to get, and a time to lose; a time to keep, and a time to cast away;
- ⁷A time to rend, and a time to sew; a time to keep silence, and a time to speak;
- ⁸ A time to love, and a time to hate; a time of war, and a time of peace.
